I am in receipt of your letter of the 1st instant regarding this vessel and have submitted the case to the Committee today in the light of the comments made by the Shipbuilders.

In the circumstances it is considered the speed restriction mentioned in my letter of the 4th ultimo can be made 340 instead of 330 R.P.M. as requested.

The vessel has accordingly been assigned a class of "S100A1" together with the various notations recommended by you and the following note will be made on the First Entry certificate:-

"The main engines not to exceed 340 revolutions per minute".

A Notice Board to this effect will require to be fitted at the Control Station and I shall be obliged if you will inform Messrs. Clelands Ltd. of the position.
