It is submitted the freeboards given on the accompanying form being those required by the Tables merit approval, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book, subject to the particulars and dimensions now supplied being verified on completion of the vessel, the sheer being of the gradual character defined in the regulations and efficient temporary covers being fitted to the tonnage opening as required by the Rules for Shelter Deck Steamers. The computation has been made on an assumed coefficient of .76 which is subject to modification if found necessary. These freeboards are for the vessel as a cargo steamer only.
