ALINS) = statutory deck line to centre of disc.


ALLUW) = The statutory deck line is 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " above the steel

ALPFU = The other lines should be marked as follow:-

ALRAW = Indian Summer 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " above centre of disc.

ALSUD = Winter 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " below centre of disc.

ALUVA = Winter North Atlantic 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " below centre of disc.
