11/3 With reference to Glasgow Reports Nos. 44413 and 44482 on a Boiler (1507) built by Messrs. Yarrow & Co. and Engines (1034) built by Messrs. Campbell & Calderwood, I beg to acquaint you that I am now informed by Messrs. Wm. McNeil & Co., Ltd. that this machinery is to be fitted on board the T.S.S. "BATAAN" at present being constructed by Messrs. W. S. Bailey & Co., Ltd. Kowloon, Hongkong, and I shall, therefore, be glad if you will kindly advise the Society's Surveyor accordingly. At the time the report on the engines was forwarded it was understood that the engines were intended for an unclassed vessel and no entry fee was, therefore, charged. As, however, this does not now appear to be the case perhaps you will be so good as to arrange with the Surveyor at Hongkong to charge an entry fee.
