Gentlemen,

I am in receipt of the letter dated 9th instant from Mr. Gilmour and Mr. McAuslan enclosing a special damage report which has been prepared by them of their survey of the new steamer "TIME", and in returning this document herewith I have to acquaint you that the last two lines of the report should be altered to read as follows:- "so as to place the vessel in as good and efficient a condition as before the damage was sustained". When this alteration has been made you will be at liberty to hand the report to the builders who requested the survey upon payment of the fee.

It is considered the amount of the fee charged should be £10-10-0.
