

S.S. "TIME".

It is submitted that the special damage report on S.S. "TIME" received from Messrs. Gilmour & McAuslan dated 9th September 1912 should be returned to the West Hartlepool Office, and that the Surveyors should be informed that provided they alter the last two lines of the report as to read as follows, viz;-

"so as to place the vessel in as good and efficient
"a condition as before the damage was sustained"
You are at liberty to hand this report to Mr. Priestman, Builder of the vessel, who requested the survey, upon payment by him of the fee chargeable in the case. It is considered this fee should be £10.10.0.

It is further submitted that Messrs. J. Priestman & Co., the Builders of the vessel, should be informed that in accordance with their request a special survey has been held on the S.S. "TIME" by the Principal Surveyors at West Hartlepool & Middlesbrough, who will hand to them on payment of the survey fee charged in the case, their damage survey report on ^{the} ~~case~~.

They should further be informed that
A request has been received from the Owners of the vessel, Messrs. Howard Smith & Co., Ltd. for a copy of this survey report, and, believing that this will have the full concurrence of Messrs. Priestman, it is proposed to accede to the Owners' request, after the report has been received by Messrs. Priestman.

A copy of the letter sent to Messrs. Priestman should be forwarded to the West Hartlepool Surveyors.
