"Steamer TIME writing tonight".

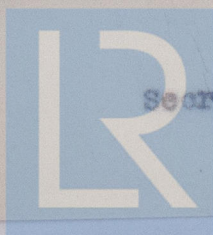
I am to add that no written statement regarding this case should be issued by you and Mr. McAuslan until it has been submitted to this Office.
