With reference to your letter of the 19th instant respecting the steamer "WARINA", I have to say that the Committee will be prepared to extend the period of grace allowed for the overdue Special Survey of this vessel until the end of the year provided, when the requisite inspection is made for the extension of the load line certificate, the Surveyors are given the opportunity of satisfying themselves of the general condition of the ship meantime.

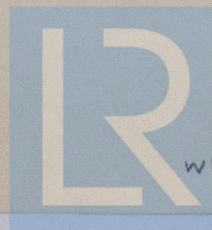
