In July last the Calcutta Surveyors stated they had been informed that this vessel was trading on the East African Coast and was expected to arrive at Bombay sometime in September, when arrangements would be made for her disposal.

In the circumstances the Bombay Surveyors were informed on the 5th instant that as the Special Survey became due in October, 1948, the Committee must ask for the ship to be inspected on arrival at Bombay, unless she is sold at once for demolition.

The Owners now write stating the vessel is operating on the East African Coast and is at present committed to a number of coal voyages. She will thereafter load a cargo of cotton from Mombasa to Bombay. The Owners therefore ask that the Committee will grant an extension until the end of this year to enable them to meet their commitments.

They add that it is intended that after the voyage to Bombay, arrangements will be made for the disposal of the ship and for her despatch to ship-breakers or other buyers.
