With reference to your S. letter of the 23rd instant respecting the motorvessel "FRANCOIS TIXIER" ex s.s. "LITTLE EVY", Rotterdam Report No. 23611 I beg to state that the twelve consecutive startings of the engines without replenishment have been held with satisfactory results and at that time the pressure dropped down in the airvessel from 30 kg. to 20 kg.

As these engines will be started at 10 kg. air pressure there was sufficiently left for another starting.
