With reference to your E. letters of the 7th of February and 12th of March respecting the motorvessel "FRANCOIS TIXIER" ex s.s. "LITTLE EVY" I beg to return herewith the plan of the pumping arrangement and have to state the following:

The reserve oil lubricating pump will be capable of supplying the main engine continuously and sufficiently of lubricating oil at full power.

With regard to the next paragraph I beg to state that the wing section will be retained as original and will be made in accordance with the Rules, Section 34, Clause 6(g).

The oil fuel will be carried in separate tanks which have already been approved.

The plan in question is forwarded under separate cover and I shall be glad if you will be so kind as to return same when found in order and stamped.
