I am in receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo enclosing plan, in duplicate, in respect of the Engine No. 32110 to be made by Messrs. Motorenwerke Mannheim A.G. to the order of Messrs. J. Salomons' Shipping & Forwarding Office N.V. and intended for the m.v. "LITTLE EVY", and with regard thereto, have to acquaint you that with 4 SCOA Oil Engines for main propelling purposes, having ^{six} cylinders 310 mm. diameter by 450 mm. stroke, span of bearings 416 mm., revolutions per minute 350, maximum pressure in cylinders 45 kg. per sq. cm., MIP 6.9 kg. per sq. cm., BHP 450, weight of flywheel 2100 kg. and diameter of flywheel 1100 mm. the proposed size of crankshaft, viz:- 190 mm. diameter, will be approved.

The plan showing details of crankshaft will also be approved, and one copy is returned herewith.

I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know at what port these oil engines will be fitted in lieu of the existing steam engines.
