S. With reference to the enquiry in your letter of the 24th ultimo, regarding the omission of the figure "1" for equipment from the class of the steamer "UALAN", I have to acquaint you that upon examination of the reports on this vessel it appears that the equipment supplied was not equivalent to the requirements of the Society's Rules, the anchors and cables had not been examined and compared with the certificates of test, and there was no third bower anchor.

Furthermore, the question of the test to which the anchors and cables were submitted would require to be very carefully looked into, as the certificates would seem to be those issued by the Germanischer Lloyd.
