The class of this vessel is subject to sheerstrake being doubled or increased in thickness in way of poop front, if this is not already done.

The Cardiff surveyors now state that a doubling plate extending nine frame spaces is fitted on inside of sheerstrake in way of poop front.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, without record of Survey & without special conditions.
