On the 28th day of December, 1932, while the vessel was in dry dock at the Sun Shipbuilding & Dry Dock Co., Chester, Pa., the Undersigned upon examination found:-

that the (a) protection of openings, (b) guard rails, (c) freeing ports, (d) means of access to crew's quarters have been maintained in an effective condition, and that, in my opinion, there have been no alterations made to the hull or superstructures which would affect the calculations determining the position of the load lines.


