We enclose herewith a letter received from the Managers of the S.S. "CRANLEY" from which it will be noted the vessel has been sold, subject to the vessel being delivered at Dublin.

The Year of Grace has expired and while a Specification for repairs has been made out, no repairs have been effected. The Managers therefore were informed that it would not be possible to issue an Interim Load Line Certificate without the Committee's instructions.

I enclose the Specification of repairs and Mr J.J. Wilson, now in the London Office, carried through this survey.

Kindly return the Specification and pencil draft of shell drillings with your reply, and we would be pleased if you will kindly arrange for Mr Wilson to forward a Rpt. 8 and 9 in brief outline to which the Specification can be attached so that this case can be submitted formally to the Committee and an appropriate fee charged for the services rendered in making out the Specification.


