The Ministry of Transport granting permission for
the sale and transfer of the vessel (which has now
been granted).

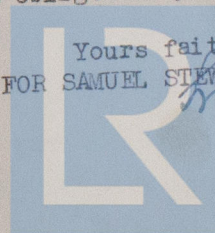
The Contract provides for delivery of
