The Company receives goods or animals only on the condition that it shall not be liable for any loss thereof or damage or delay thereto howsoever or whenever caused, whether due to any negligence of any of its servants or agents, or to any unfitness of any description of place, plant, or appliance or to any unseaworthiness of any ship or craft of any description, or to any improper deviation, or otherwise, and in addition to and without lessening the effect of the above condition, goods or animals when shipped are shipped on or subject to the terms and conditions contained in the latest edition of the authorised form of the London Short Sea Traders' Association's Bill of Lading applicable to the particular voyage for which they are shipped, a copy of which can be supplied or seen on application at the Chief Office of the Company, 15, Trinity Square, London, E.C. 3, or at any Branch Office. The Company can, if so instructed by its customers and on their behalf, effect insurances at Lloyd's on goods or animals against usual Sea risks at low rates. Application for rates and terms of insurance should be made to the Company at the Chief Office at 15, Trinity Square, London, E.C. 3, or at any Branch Office.

The Company has liberty to ship goods of any description or animals on deck. All goods or animals are subject to a general lien for any money which may be due to the Company from Shippers or Consignees in respect of any previous shipment or transaction. Goods or animals not taken away within 48 hours after being landed, or on which there is any undischarged lien, may, in the absolute discretion of the Company, be sold without notice. Any goods which in the Company's opinion may be dangerous may be destroyed or disposed of if delivery is not taken immediately on ship's arrival.

NOTE.—Merchants and others are requested to note that it is the frequent practice to send forward Bills of Lading by the ship without waiting for Mate's receipt: parties interested must give notice at the Company's Office when it is desired Bills of Lading should be retained.
