~~for issue when~~ the Bary Surveyors be requested to confirm the Freeboard length & the Mld Breadth of vessel as these reported appear to be the Registered Dimensions.

The length should be measured on <sup>the</sup> summer load waterline from fore side of stem to after side of sternpost & the surveyors should also confirm that the length of forecable & hook were measured from these same two points.

The surveyors should be advised that the arrangement of freeboards will be subject to the next coaming 19" in height being adequately supported & <sup>the</sup> the mainmast being provided with canvas covers unless these are of worn down pattern.

The surveyors shall report the number of sails & the shoring of stanchions on fore & bridge & the manthings



of hatch beams & fore & afters.
