Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the correspondence which passed between us in January last respecting the Motor Vessel "MUDO", formerly classed with the Germanischer Lloyd, I have to acquaint you that the Committee have now had before them a report on the vessel received from the Society's Surveyor at Ipswich from which it is noted the main engine has been removed ashore overhauled and refitted on board and the existing clutch gearing completely opened up and examined and made satisfactory pending the receipt of the new clutch gearing.

A General Examination has been carried out at this time in drydock of the hull and some keel plating and ceilings under hatchways renewed and repairs effected to the windlass.

In view of the report now received the Committee have assigned to the vessel a docking date 2,45 and the notation "Examined L.R. 4,45" valid for twelve months on the understanding that the clutch gearing will be renewed at the first opportunity.
