LEANDROS. London, Feb. 14. The following message has been received from the master of the steamer Leandros, dated Basia, Feb. 13: Leandros (Marseilles for Heraklion) sunk off north Corsica last Saturday afternoon Feb. 12. All crew saved.

LEANDROS. Ajaccio, Feb. 15. Steamer Leandros sank at 2 p.m. on Feb. 12 in deep water 22 miles from Minervio, Cape Corso; impossible to refloat. Lloyd's Agents per Salvage Association. (See issue of Feb. 15.)

LEANDROS. Paris, Feb. 24. Information received from Marseilles states that the Panamanian steamer Leandros, Marseilles for Piraeus, with 203 tons of cargo, consisting mainly of carbon disulphide, sank near Cape Corso owing to a leak. Journal de la Marine Marchande. (See issue of Feb. 17.)

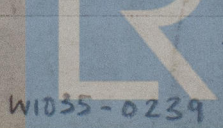
