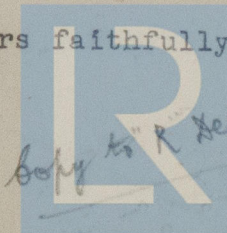
Referring to telephonic conversation, I have to inform you this vessel has just arrived in London from India, and is lying at No. 26 shed, Royal Albert Dock. Her inward cargo is for London, and Dundee, at which latter port she will complete discharge and, it is hoped, be disposed of there as scrap.

Her Freeboard Certificate expired on the 31st May last, and I should be glad if you could kindly arrange for this to be extended to cover her for the passage, not only from London to Dundee, but also for any other subsequent U.K. port to which she may be sent for ultimate disposal. It is suggested, therefore, for your consideration, that the certificate may be extended to the end of July, 1948.
