

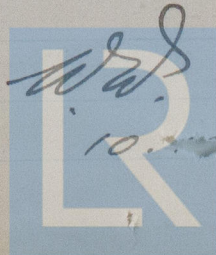
S. S. "Nirvana".

Captain Sedale phoned this morning stating that this vessel was to be brought to this country with a view to survey for reclassification, but meantime was on its way to New York from whence it would proceed for one voyage before coming to this country.

He requested that the vessel might be surveyed in New York with a view to the issue of a gruboard certificate as an unclassified vessel, for a period of one year.

The vessel was built to the Society's class but the class was withdrawn in 1917.

It is submitted the New York Surveyors be informed, and instructed to survey the vessel in dry dock in accordance with Board of Trade Circular 1416, as far as General condition is concerned, and report full particulars on form Rpt. 8. Freeboard certificates valid for a period of one year should also be sent to the Surveyors for issue when the marking is verified and the condition of the vessel found satisfactory. They should forward the usual verification form to this office.
