General Examination became due 9,47.


The vessels class is subject to a bower anchor and 15 fathoms of chain cable being supplied.

The VANCOUVER Surveyors report 8,47 vessel examined afloat and requirements of a General Examination complied with. On account of wear and tear, all main hatchway covers were renewed.

A bower anchor and 15 fathoms of chain cable (as above) ~~was~~, placed on board and marks of same verified with certificates.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to remain as classed with record of "Examined 8,47" as recommended, without special condition.
