cable being supplied at the first convenient opportunity,*

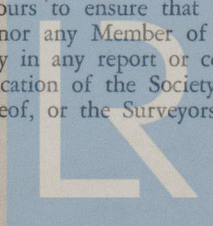
being fit to carry. dry and perishable cargoes.
