This vessel grounded in the River Seine on the 4th November, 1949.

She sustained a heavy leak amidships, and after being refloated and towed to Rouen she was found to be badly damaged.

The Owners have informed the Copenhagen Surveyors that this steamer (which has arrived in London in tow), has been sold for breaking up purposes after having been condemned on account of the grounding.
