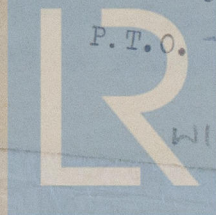

With reference to the S.S. "STAL" which recently arrived at this Port for General Examination, Renewal Freeboard Survey and fitting of additional bulkheads, we are informed by the local M.W.T. Surveyors that only such repairs as would be required to make the vessel immediately seaworthy for passage to North American Atlantic Port could now be carried out at this Port, and that all further work could be carried out on arrival at destination, the vessel having to sail almost immediately.

In the circumstances, as the existing Freeboard Certificate expired on 31st January 1943, a provisional Freeboard Certificate has been issued (copy attached) to enable the vessel to make the proposed passage to U.S.A. or Canada, all other work being left in abeyance.

The Chief Engineer states that the boiler survey and repairs to the main turbines were recently carried out.
