PROVISIONAL LOAD LINE CERTIFICATE

This is to Certify that

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of

the Owners' Representative, survey the S.S. "STAL", 2242 gross tons of London, whilst lying afloat in Alexandra Dock, Hull, on May 16th, 1943 and subsequently, for the purpose of issuing a temporary Load Line Certificate.

The decks, casings, ventilators and coamings, closing appliances, hatchway coamings covers, fittings and battening gear, have all been generally examined and found or placed in an efficient condition for the proposed voyage.

The freeboard marks on the ship's sides have been verified and found correct in accordance with the attached Freeboard Certificate No. 18950 which expired on January 31st, 1943.

This provisional Certificate is issued for passage from Hull to North American Atlantic Port where a General Examination and Freeboard Renewal Survey will be held.
