Referring to my letter of the 22nd December last respecting the steamer "MARISO", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case of this vessel before them at their meeting today, and I am pleased to inform you that as a result of an examination of the plans and of the reports received, the vessel will be eligible for a class of "100A1" on completion of the survey for classification.

You are doubtless aware it was not convenient to complete this survey at either Dundee or Leith, and in the circumstances it has been decided to assign notations of "100A1 (Class Contemplated)" and "Examined 11.42." pending the completion of the survey, to indicate that in the meantime the vessel is considered to be in an efficient condition for twelve months from that date.

A notation of "B.S.11.42." has also been assigned in respect of the Boiler Survey.

With regard to the screwshaft, I am requested to inform you that if this shaft has not been examined during the last four years, it is considered arrangements should be made for it to be drawn for survey at the next drydocking. According to the latest information available here (Germanischer Lloyd Register Book of 1939) the shaft was renewed in July 1935, but if you have any further information on this subject it will be appreciated if you will kindly advise me.

The eventual fees for the Survey for Classification if held in this country will be as follows:-
