With reference to your report No. 9342 on the steamer "MARISSO", I have to inform you that this vessel was duly inspected whilst in drydock at Leith but it was not convenient to complete the survey for classification on that occasion.

Before submitting the case to the Committee, however, I shall be obliged if you will let me know whether, as a result of the examination made by you, it is considered that the condition of the vessel and the bunkers externally is such that in your opinion a notation of "Examined 11.42", valid for twelve months, can be assigned. I shall also be obliged if you will let me know whether all the spaces which were insulated for the carriage of refrigerated produce have had the insulation removed and whether the refrigerating machinery is still on board.
