

We duly received your letter of the 22nd inst., regarding

S.S. "MARISO"

Mr. Houston stated by telephone this afternoon that this ship has been under survey in drydock at Leith, and has now left the port.

The Leith Surveyors have forwarded a report of the survey to Wokingham, on which they have given the following particulars of the equipment:-

Chain cable. 300 fathoms of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " dia. stud link.

Anchors. 1st bower - 4030 kg.
2nd bower - 4020 kg.
3rd bower - 4000 kg.
Stream anchor - 1240 kg.

Mr. Houston added that it was not possible to obtain any particulars of tests, nor could the Surveyors furnish a profile plan with particulars of erections.
