the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Master survey the s.s. "MARISO" of Willemstad 7659 tons gross, whilst lying afloat in Imperial Dock, Leith, and also in Imperial Dry Dock, Leith, on 2nd December, 1942 and subsequent dates, for the purpose of ascertaining present condition of parts now examined as follows, in continuation of 'On Survey' Report issued at Cape Town on the 27th July, 1942:-

Closing appliances, holds, shelter and 'Tween Decks; hatches, coamings, hatch covers, battens, tarpaulins, close and spar ceiling, all examined and found efficient.

Drydocking:-

The vessel has now been placed in drydock, bottom and rudder cleaned, examined and recoated. Rudder portable plates in way of rudder bearings (Simplex type) removed and external surfaces of bearings examined as far as possible, and found in efficient condition. The sea cocks and valves have also been opened up and examined.

The following parts remain to be examined and reported upon:- W.F. Doors; air pipes.
