the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Singapore Barbour Board, attend at their Machine Shop at Keppel Harbour on the 28th September, 1940 and subsequent dates for the purpose of examining one three-bladed solid bronze propeller which is intended for the Steel Twin Screw Motorship "ANASTASIA", which is owned by the Nederlandsch-Indische Tankstoomboot Maats.

A tensile test piece (2" x 0.564") was taken from the casting and it gave a tensile breaking strength of 30.2 tons per square inch and a percentage of elongation of 40.6.

The finished propeller has been examined and found to be, so far as can be seen, sound and free from defects.

For purposes of identification it has been stamped on the boss as follows:-
