Steam Trawler for Les Pecheries de Fecamp, France.

Mr. Richardson of the Aberdeen Office has telephoned to-day stating this vessel had now been completed with the exception that the windlass, which was ordered from Denmark, has not been delivered and considerable time may elapse yet before delivery takes place.

In the circumstances, the Owners desire to place the vessel in service and they propose to fit the windlass when delivery is obtained. The Surveyors inquire as to whether the Owners' proposal can be agreed to.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Surveyors be informed that the proposal can be agreed to provided alternative arrangements, similar to those approved in the cases of Messrs. Hall Russell's Nos. 706 & 707 at the end of June, 1929, be adopted so as to ensure the efficiency of the mooring arrangements meantime.
