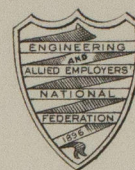

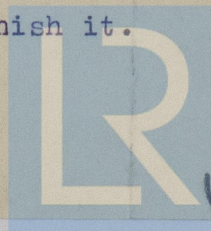
New Trawler No. 751.

This trawler is being built for Les Pêcheries de Fécamp, 25 Quai Bérigny, Fécamp, and Mr. Joseph Duhamel is the Administrateur Délégué,

In accordance with French Law the owner has to make a declaration of new construction being put in hand and when a vessel is being built abroad this has to be addressed to the local Consular Authority, and if a vessel is being built under the supervision of a recognised Classification Society, there has to be attached to this declaration a certification from the Classification Society in question that they have been instructed to carry out the necessary supervision, and are undertaking it.

For this vessel the owner has asked us to obtain a formal declaration from your Society to this effect, and we accordingly request you to furnish it.
