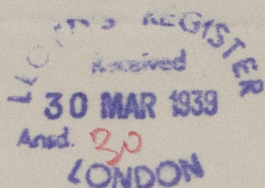

Dear Sir,

I beg to acquaint you that Messrs. Hall, Russell & Co., Ltd. state they will submit, in the course of a day or two, plans of a trawler 216' in length and somewhat similar to their Yard No. 732.

The plans for No. 732 were approved in your Office in January, 1935 and, in view of this, and as it is anticipated that the numerals of the new vessel will be beyond the upper limits of the Tables in the Trawler Rules, I shall be glad to know whether the plans should be dealt with in this Office. If the plans are to be dealt with here, I am desirous to enquire whether the Tables may be interpolated and shall be glad if you will kindly forward a copy of the scantling sheet and approved plans for the previous vessel referred to.

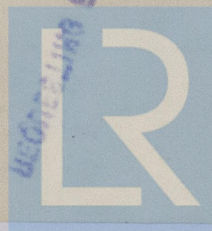
A reply by return of post is desired in this case.
