M. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th ultimo regarding the Twin Screw Motor Ship "BONZO", and I note that Comm. Zanchi has indicated to you verbally his decision to complete the classification survey on this ship, under the arrangements set forth in my letter of the 10th ultimo; also that the vessel is expected to be handed over to Comm. Zanchi on or about the 6th instant at Naples.

As desired I am sending to your address, under separate cover, copies of the Trieste First Entry Reports (No. 10534) on the ship, together with copies of the following plans :-

Midship section,
Profile and decks,
After end construction,
Engine seating and double bottom in way,

At the same time I enclose for your information a copy of a letter which has to-day been addressed to the Trieste Surveyors regarding this case.

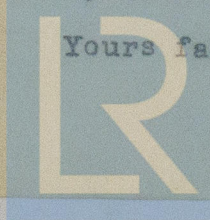
