Dear Sirs,

With reference to the First Entry Reports, forwarded by you in August last, in respect of the Twin Screw Motor Ship "BONZO", which vessel, it is understood, has been purchased by Comm.Zanchi, who desires her to be classed with this Society, it is concluded that the riveting of the seams of the side plating are treble riveted amidships as shown on the approved plans, and that the sea connections were examined, but I shall be glad if you will be so good as to confirm this.

At the same time you should state whether you are correct in reporting the diameter of rivets in the butts and lower seams of the sheerstrake and strake below to be 22 mm., and whether the spacing of this riveting is as reported.

A copy of this letter is being forwarded to Mr.Ormiston at Genoa, together with copies of the First Entry Reports and plans of the ship, in order that he may arrange for the completion of the survey.
