Midship section,  
Profile and Decks,

Stern post and rudder.

At the same time the Surveyors should be informed that a report <sup>dg</sup> ~~8~~ has not so far been received from the Trieste Surveyors.

The Trieste Surveyors should be informed it is concluded the riveting of the seams of the side plating are treble *+ that the Sea Connections were examined* riveted amidships as shown on the approved plans, but this should be confirmed.

They should also state whether they are correct in reporting the diameter of rivets in the butts and lower seams of the sheerstrake and strake below to be 22 mm. and whether the spacing of this riveting is as reported.
