Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 23th ultimo, addressed to Mr. Scott, and your cablegram of the 9th instant respecting the motor Tanker "BONZO", I have to acquaint you that careful consideration has been given to your remarks, and in view of the intimation conveyed in your cablegram it is considered that a suitable total fee for the classification of this vessel would be 21,000 lire, which is equivalent to 30% of the fee which would have been charged for special survey during construction.

With the amount already paid, namely 8390 lire, this would leave 12,610 lire chargeable to Commander Zanchi, and I trust that he will be agreeable to complete the classification survey under these terms.

As regards the date of Special Survey for which the vessel would be eligible on completion, I have to inform you that provided the Surveyors satisfy themselves in regard to the condition of the parts examined in August, 1934, the vessel
