Motor Tanker "BONZO"


This vessel was built in 1931 by the Cantieri Riuniti dell'Adriatico to the classification of the Norske Veritas.

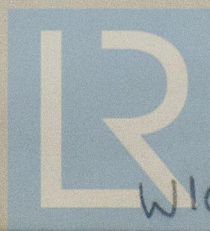
In August 1934 the Trieste Surveyors reported the vessel partly surveyed with a view to classification with this Society. To complete the survey the following remained to be done :-

The after cofferdam, oil fuel bunkers, and double bottom tanks under the motors to be opened out and examined internally and tested, and scantlings in way verified. Main motor seatings to be examined and after peak tank to be tested. The area of the rudder requires to be reduced.

The vessel has been sold to Comm. Zanchi, Genoa, and a cablegram has now been received from Mr. Ormiston stating that the new Owner is very anxious to obtain survey date when classification is completed.

It is submitted Mr. Ormiston be informed that provided the Society's Surveyors satisfy themselves in regard to the ^{CONDITION OF THE} parts examined in August 1934 the date to be assigned for the Special Survey for classification could be the date of the completion of the remaining items of the survey.
