Dear Mr. Scott,

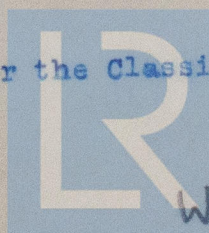
I am informed by the Trieste Office that Comm. Zanchi of Genoa, has bought this vessel and that she will be handed over at Naples or Marseilles during the early part of next month.

Following upon your letter "S" of the 8th August last to Trieste Office, the greater part of the Classification Survey was held by the Trieste Surveyors in conjunction with the Registro Italiano, and certain fees were charged and paid for this part survey, by Messrs Cantieri Riuniti dell'Adriatico, to whom the vessel at that time belonged, and it was then anticipated that the survey would be completed with the same Owners.

I have had a conversation with Comm. Zanchi, (who, I understand from the Trieste Office and also from himself had so far specified R.I. Class only) and he appears to be disposed to complete the survey to our class, but would like to have some indications regarding:-

- 1) What the fees would amount to?
- 2) What date could be assigned for the Classification Survey by this Society?

It is noted from Trieste Report N°10534 that little remains done to complete the Classification Survey, and in order that there be a reasonable probability of Comm. Zanchi completing this Survey this Society, I would suggest that the fees which might be indicated should not exceed the following:-

I suggest this percentage of 20 on the basis of a practice of several years ago for vessels classed with the Registro Italiano only in addition to Lloyd's Register, and, in this case, I understand, there would only be the Registro Italiano Class in addition to our class.

As regards the completion of the survey, it appears that Lit. 7500.- would be an adequate fee, since it should involve not more than about three full days' surveys.

I understand from the Trieste Surveyors, that the R.I. granted a temporary Classification Certificate which expires at the end of June, when the outstanding items should be dealt with, but if the vessel is to be dry docked next month for some damage, it is possible that the outstanding items could then be dealt with, if not, would, I presume, be dealt with in June next on the expiry of the period of the temporary R.I. Certificate.



I should be glad if you would kindly give me an indication  
of the foregoing at your early convenience, so that I may dis-  
cuss the matter further with Comm. Zanchi, early next week.
