Messrs. Cantieri Riuniti dell'Adriatico, with whom we have been in touch today, state that the ultimate classification of this vessel and the time for the completion of the survey depend largely on the desire of the buyer.

The vessel is still on the market and, while negotiations with several parties are in progress, none are so far sufficiently advanced to warrant either the completion of the survey for the Society's classification or the definite abandonment of same.
