Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of Mr. Constantini's letter of the 1st instant, having further reference to the question of the classification with this Society of the Motor Tanker "BONZO", which I note has again been discussed with Dr. Sai, of the Cantieri Riuniti dell'Adriatico.

It is noted that Dr. Sai has confirmed that the sale of the vessel to Norwegian Owners is at present being negotiated, in which case only the Norske Veritas class would be retained. In view, however, of the circumstances as mentioned in your letter, and of the fact that arrangements have been made for the vessel to proceed to Monfalcone, where certain parts of the hull and machinery are to be prepared for the inspection of the R.I. Surveyors, I am directed to say that there will be no objection, in view of the possibility of the Society's classification being considered, to your arranging to survey, together with the R.I., the parts which are to be opened up for inspection, and for the services rendered, to charge a suitable proportion of the

survey fee in respect of the amount of work done.

I therefore cabled you to-day, as under,
which is hereby confirmed, viz:-

"BONZO
GAHOM - Please refer to your letter of the 1st instant
NONUS - proposal agreed to
LIXAG - letter follows".

At the same time, I think it well to
remind you that the plans of this vessel have been fully
examined in this Office, and compared with the requirements
of the Rules, and on account of the nature of the work
done here it is considered that a further fee of £50
should be charged.

I would, however, add that in the
event of the vessel being classed with this Society
the amount of the fee for classification would have to
be specially considered, and when this is fixed this would
be reduced by the amount of the fee for your services plus
the fee of £50 referred to above.

You will therefore be good enough to
be guided accordingly.
