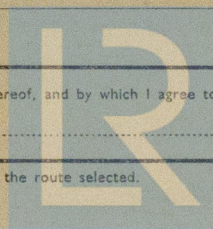

CONDITIONS

- 1.—Either the Postmaster-General or any Telegraph Company or Government, by whom this Telegram is or would be forwarded, may decline to forward the Telegram although it has been received for that purpose; but in such case the amount paid for transmission shall be refunded to the sender at his request.
- 2.—Neither the Postmaster-General nor any officer of the Post Office nor any Telegraph Company or Government, by whom this Telegram is or would be forwarded, shall be liable to make compensation for any loss, injury, or damage arising from non-transmission or non-delivery of the Telegram, or delay, or error, or omission in the transmission or delivery thereof, through whatever cause such non-transmission, non-delivery, delay, error, or omission shall have occurred.
- 3.—This Telegram shall be forwarded in all respects in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations with reference to Imperial and Foreign Telegrams made pursuant to the Telegraph Acts, and the provisions of such Regulations shall be deemed to be binding not only between the Sender and the Postmaster-General, but between the Sender and any Telegraph Company or Government by whom this Telegram is or would be forwarded in the ordinary course of the Telegraphic Service.
