Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 16th instant regarding the proposed classification with this Society of the N.V. "BONZO", we are forwarding, under separate cover, for the consideration of the Committee, another plan of midship section and main oiltight bulkhead (in duplicate).

The Builders explained that the plan forwarded with our letter of the 12th instant was the proposed "as built" midship section, which had never been quite completed, thus accounting for the lack of certain particulars.

The following particulars regarding the equipment of anchors and chain cables, as supplied to this vessel, have been obtained from the Builders:-

2 stockless bower anchors, 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ cwt, each.
 1 " " anchor, 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ cwt.
 1 stream anchor (ex stock), 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ cwt.
 285 fathoms 2 8/16" stud link chain cable.
 130 " 6" tow line,
 120 " 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " stream wire,
 2 at 100 fathoms 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " hawsers,
 2 at 100 " 8" hemp warps,
 also sundry ropes as specified by the Owners.

We shall be glad to be informed in due course whether the above equipment will entitle the vessel to the assignment of the figure "1".
