The class is subject to permanent repairs being effected to the p.s. of the forecastle at the Owners' convenience.

The Surveyor appointed by Lloyd's agent acting on behalf of the French Naval authorities reports that this vessel has been transformed for patrol purposes.

According to a statement of the Chief Engineer there is 8 millimetres clearance between pintles and gudgeons.

It is stated also that the vessel will shortly proceed to some French port, probably Bordeaux, with a view to requisite surveys being held there.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without Record of Survey, subject to the rudder being examined at the first convenient opportunity, and as above.


