Having remade the flooding calculations of this vessel we find that the moulded draught of the "BAUDOUINVILLE" in that respect could be 8.30m.

The Administration de la Marine agrees to this new figure subject to approval by your Society.

The Owners, Messrs. Cie. Maritime Belge, do not desire such a high draught, but they would like to have authorisation to load to an allseasons draught of 7.85m.

We shall therefore be glad to know if your Society would agree to adopt for the "BAUDOUINVILLE" an all seasons moulded draught of 7.85m.
