Dear Sirs,

M. I am returning under separate cover two copies of each of the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 15th instant, of details of artificial ventilation for Messrs. Cockerill's No. 675, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the arrangements be carried out as shewn and amended and to your satisfaction, they will be approved.

With reference to the second paragraph of your letter, I have to inform you that the question of the stays to the ventilator coamings on and above "B" deck has already been considered on the plans submitted for a number of these ventilators. A general ruling on the subject cannot be given, as this must depend on the height and position of the ventilators. In any particular instance where you may be in doubt, you should submit the Builders' proposals to this Office.

Means of closing need no be provided for the coamings of the mechanical ventilators situated on and above "B" deck.

The remaining copies of the plans are being retained for reference.
