M. I am returning to your address to-day, under separate cover, two copies of the plan, forwarded with Mr. Wray's letter of the 23rd ultimo, of Welin Maclachlan davits, type PHA, 5v, proposed to be supplied to Messrs. Soc. Anon. John Cockerill's Yard No. 675, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the davits be constructed as shewn and to your satisfaction, they will be approved for the maximum load and outreach indicated on the plan.

The steel to be used in the construction of the davits must be made by the Open Hearth process at Works recognised by the Committee and be tested in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

You should satisfy yourselves that the workmanship is sound and pay special attention to the electric welding of the davits.


The Rules for the Application of Electric Arc Welding to Ship Construction must be complied with, and the electrodes used comply with Section 4, Clauses 1-9 of these Rules.
